

Yale Cordage - Prize with a View - Official Rules

No purchase necessary. Void where prohibited. Some restrictions apply. Limit one entry per email address. You need not be present to win.

The sweepstakes: From October 23, 2009 through February 28, 2010 Yale Cordage, Inc will promote, by means of its' current Arborist Catalog and Website the opportunity to submit entries to win a grand prize as detailed below. Advertising may also be used to promote the sweepstakes beginning October 23, 2009 through February 28, 2010. Odds of winning will depend on the number of qualified entries.

Eligibility: In order to submit entries, persons must be 18 years or older. Persons entering from a country other than the United States, must have a valid passport and be able to get themselves to a major US airport to claim airline tickets for departure to site. Limit one entry per email address. Any individuals (including but not limited to employees, consultants, independent contractors, and interns) who have, within the past six months, performed services for Yale Cordage, Inc or any organizations responsible for sponsoring, fulfilling, administering, advertising or promoting the contest or supplying the prize, and/or their respective parent, subsidiary, affiliated and successor companies, and immediate family and household members of such individuals, are not eligible to enter or play.
